BOARD INITIATES FIREWATCH PROJECT

The RSF Association is collaborating with FireWatch to develop a plan to help the Covenant become a more prepared and fire-safe community. The Board approved the project after a presentation by FireWatch at the September 5, 2019, Board meeting. Click [here](#) to view the FireWatch presentation.

FireWatch will provide vital information to the community, fire department, and residents on wildfire risks, impacts, and mitigation strategies. Using aerial mapping and algorithms, FireWatch creates strategic maps of vegetative fuels for community leaders to understand and identify fire risks and assist and communicate those risks to the Association and homeowners. The project will establish a scientific baseline for wildfire risk mapping and monitoring. The results will be communicated to community leaders and the fire agency for response and action. Once the mapping is completed, the Association will communicate and educate members on specific steps they can take to lessen fire risk on their properties.
